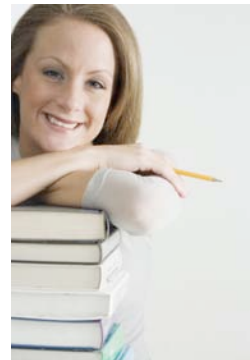
Call for Volunteers
